

Number of meals served slightly down in 2024 (level of 2022)

In Greytown, the feeding project serves a hot meal almost every Tuesday and Thursday to people in need, irrespective of their age. **7 volunteers** prepare the meals and also distribute gifts before public holidays. The project is closed on national holidays and during the African summer (mid-Dec to mid-Jan).

After an increase in recent years, the number of meals served is slightly lower again in 2024.

18'144 meals

(-5%, 19'117 in 2023 and 18'866 in 2022). One meals costs around **0.25** € (5 ZAR).



Additional gifts were again distributed to children and the needy on Nelson Mandela day (18.7.) and before Christmas.

The **age** of the people coming to the feeding project ranges from 2 years to 78 years. The **average** is 38 years (25 years in 2023).

80% of all cost are covered by donations from Siyabonga. The rest is covered by local companies.

Ø193 meals / day

(-8%, most meals were again distributed before Christmas: 324, same as in 2023).

Feeding project was open **94 Tage** again in 2024 (95 days in 2023 and 2022).
