Number of children has risen again. Average age of children has also risen from 11 to 13 (as before Corona).

37 leavers (-24%, 49 in 2021)



Continuously children are placed in families. The number of children who had to leave the home involuntarily (e.g. due to misconduct) has decreased significantly.

1 involuntary leavers (10 in 2021)30 in foster care (37 in 2021)

Number of children in therapy increased again (from 47 children in 2021 to 58 children in 2022, +23%) Significantly more children in psychotherapy (increased from 6 to 22 children), especially after suicide of one child.




Number of HIV-positive children falls for the third year in a row.

24 orphans (-33%, 36 in 2021)




Number of employees constant. Buildings were renovated
