

Township residents are supported regularly

In 2023 approx. **166 aid** packages have been distributed (-5%, approx. 175 in 2022), including food, hygiene and disinfection articles, as well as adult diapers.



Trips to clinics and governmental authorities are

made as required (approx. 10 to clinics) and 10 to authorities).

Church services

are still held with approx. 10 church goers per week, but many now go to services elsewhere.

As a result, there are **no** longer bible studies and choir rehearsals.



School uniforms

were again purchased for several children aged 5 to 15 years (mainly shoes, socks, shirts but also uniform jackets and pants). Per child **Ca. 25€** (ca. 510 ZAR)



Vegetables and salad grows well in greenhouse and private gardens. It is planned to purchase and distribute water barrels in the future.
