New project manager continues the work in the preschools and villages

In the summer 2021, Paul Moolman took over the project management and continues the previous work with much commitment. In the preschools, the focus was on **maintenance and protection against burglars and the provision of food.**

The preschools reopened in 2021 for the children, who thus also received regular hot meals in school.

Per month, about 30 families (always varying) were provided with basic necessities, which is less than during Covid-19 (ca. 60), but still significantly more than before the pandemic (ca. 19).

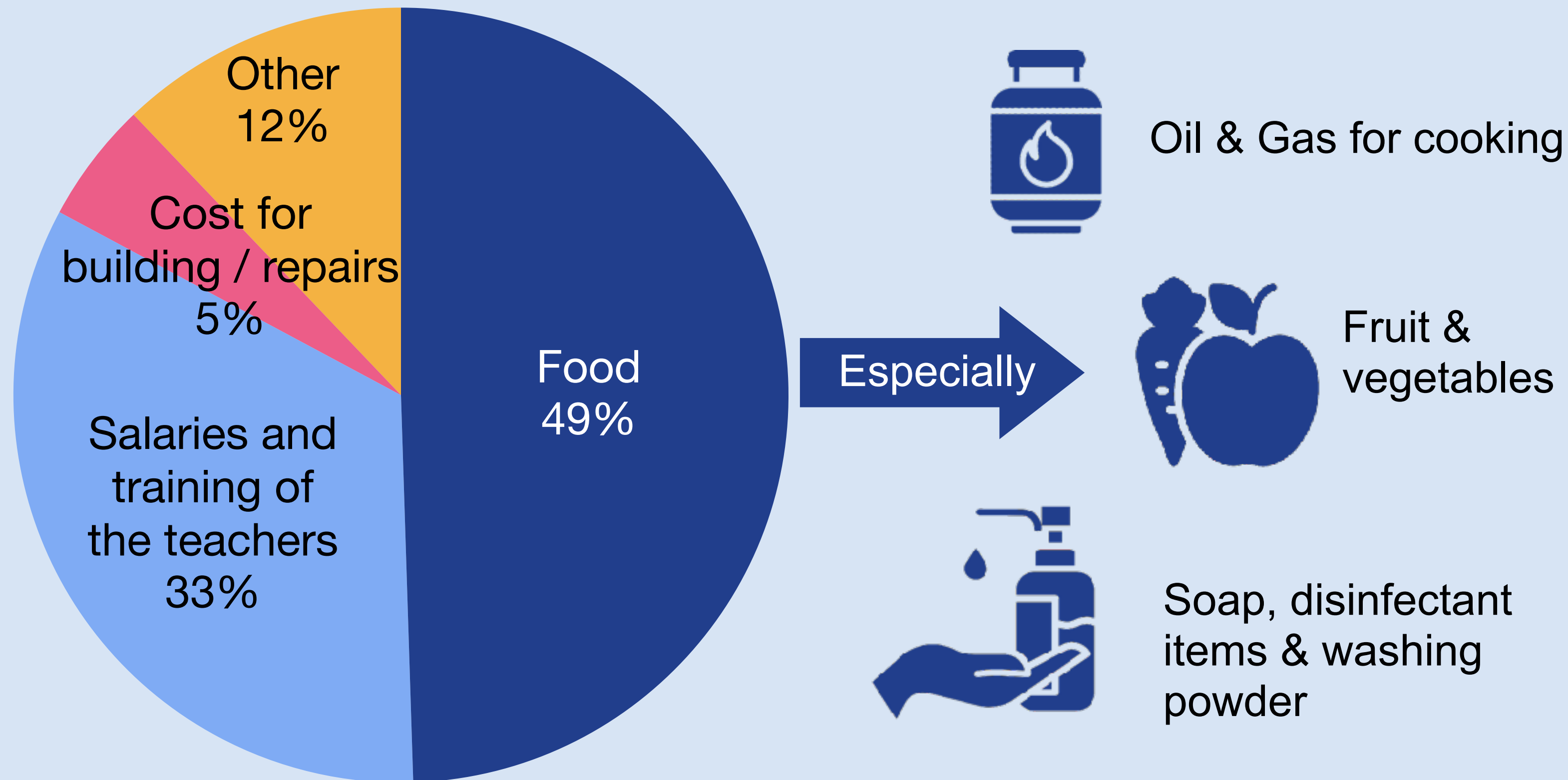

Village project is fully supported financially by Siyabonga, but more donations in kind are received (e.g. for building material)

The majority of the donations continue to be used for cooking gas and food for the preschools and families. The share of salaries and especially for the training of teachers has increased again when the schools reopened.
